

# Ordeal Packing Instructions



## Welcome Ordeal Candidate!

Upon arriving at camp you will go to the dining hall to check-in. Please be dressed in your Class A uniform and have your medical form part A and B ready to turn in.

After check-in you will report to the pool pavilion to assemble your horseshoe roll if you haven't already done so. You will leave all of your other gear under the pavilion. You will meet your guides for the weekend and await further instructions.

Below is everything you'll need for the Friday night of your ordeal is listed below, along with instructions on how to pack it in a horseshoe roll.

## Gear For Your Horseshoe Roll

- Poncho, tarp, or heavy plastic sheet (~8'x10')
- Sleeping Bag and/or Blanket
- Toiletries & medications as needed (inside a sealed bag)
- Work Clothes
- Work Gloves
- Paracord or string to tie-up the roll

Pack everything listed above inside, or on top of, your sleeping bag and then roll your sleeping bag with your tarp around it - per the directions on the right.

## Additional Gear To Bring

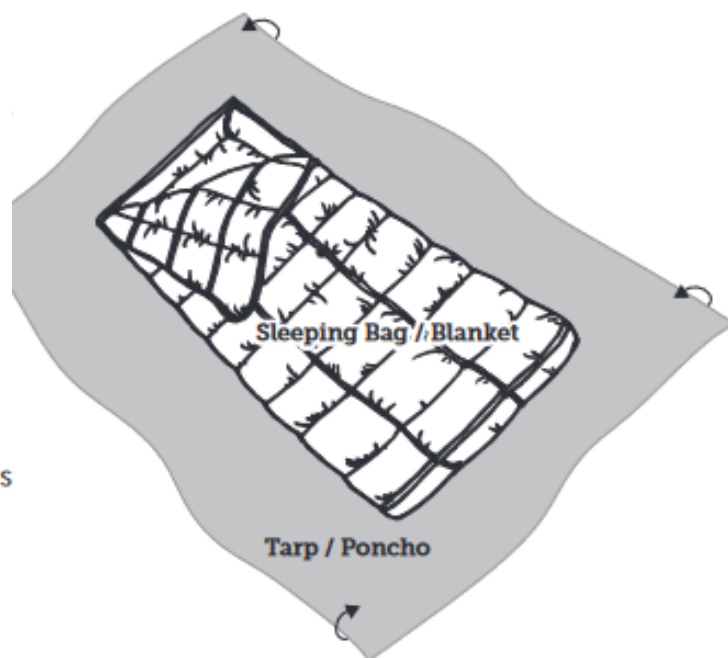
**\*\* But do NOT pack inside the horseshoe roll \*\***

- Water Bottle / Hydration pack
- Flashlight
- Pocket Knife
- Bug repellent (optional)

Please Note: You will sleep out under the stars on your first night with only the equipment you bring, so be prepared. In the case of severe weather, you will be moved under cover.

## Making Your Horseshoe Roll

- Fold the long sides of poncho over the sleeping bag, this will help seal the ends
- Then start rolling at one end
- Finished roll should be about 5 feet long
- Tie around the roll to hold it together
- Fold in half and then tie the two ends together



## Finished Horseshoe Roll

Wear over your right shoulder and across your body to keep your hands free.
